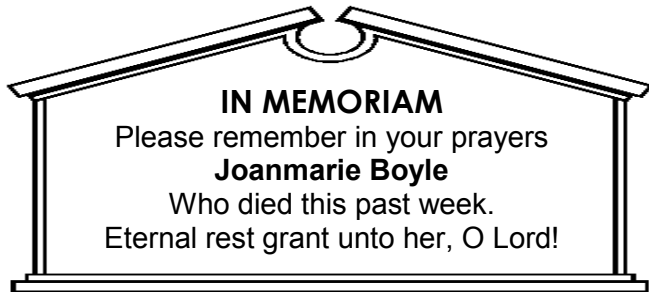

### An Invitation to You

If you have not been attending Mass regularly, we take this opportunity to welcome you back home, and to invite you warmly to return every Sunday and Holy Day.

From time to time we are called upon to issue a letter affirming that a particular individual is a practicing Catholic. Such letters can be issued only for those who are registered parishioners, and who attend Sunday Mass at St. Elizabeth's on a regular basis.

Registration as a parishioner is limited by church law to those who live within the established boundaries of the parish. However, in some cases an exception can be made. Further information can be obtained by calling the parish office. Registration is required for baptisms and weddings.

If you are already a registered parishioner and practicing Catholic, consider becoming more involved in the life of the parish. There are many opportunities, e.g.: office volunteer, school volunteer, Choir, Cantor, Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Altar Server, Liturgy of the Word for Children, Religious Education, Athletic Association, Golden Agers, RCIA, and the Altar Guild. Again, if you are interested, call the parish office.

A note about baptisms. Please notify the parish, as early as possible, when you are expecting a baby. This enables us to reserve a place for you in the baptismal ceremony scheduled for the month you prefer. We ask that you do this, not only for the first pregnancy, but also for all those with which the Lord may bless you. In this way, we can help you avoid the disappointment of not being able to have a baptism in the month for which you had been planning.

Finally, if there have been any difficulties with regard to any of these matters in the past, we are truly sorry. Our hope is that in this beautiful season of Easter, we may all find a way to put behind us any unpleasantness, which may have arisen in the past, and to keep trying to be the loving family the Lord has called us to be.
