## OUR LENTEN OBLIGATION

The Lenten obligation, as determined for Catholics in the United States by our bishops, requires that **fasting**, for all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59, be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The law of **abstinence from meat** is to be observed, by all Catholics who are 14 years and older, on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

## FREE TAX PREPARATION
