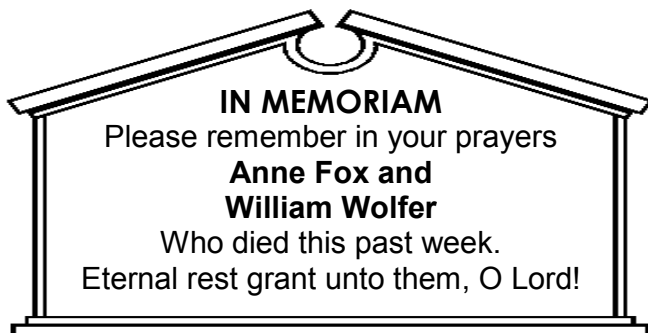

Who are the 'Helpers of God's Precious Infants'? We are a Catholic, pro-life initiative. Helpers' activities are centered on the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the Rosary. Helpers was recognized and approved for the Diocese of Allentown by Bishop Thomas J. Welsh in 1996. The second Saturday of each month the Helpers Pilgrimage begins with Holy Mass at 8:00 am at Notre Dame of Bethlehem Church, 1861 Catasauqua Rd. After Mass we begin the rosary and process from the church to the abortion mill via car. Those unable to witness at the mill may remain in the church to pray the rosary. Helpers maintain a prayerful silence. We focus on the 15 decades of the rosary, with an appropriate hymn after each decade.
