In an article in the Morning Call (6/11), it was reported that there are forty confirmed cases of swine flu in Lehigh County, third highest number in Pennsylvania. Dr. Jahre, chief of infectious diseases at St. Luke's said that while the swine flu isn't any more deadly than the regular flu it remains a concern because it can morph into a more deadly form. In view of that concern, we ask you to consider receiving Holy Communion on the hand rather than the tongue for the present. Also, it might be safer to exchange the sign of the peace with a nod rather than a hand shake.
