

Governance

Saint Elizabeth Regional School is a Catholic School supported by two parishes, Saint Elizabeth of Hungary, Whitehall and Saint Mary – Annunciation BVM, Catasauqua. The school is under the jurisdiction of the Diocese of Allentown, Department of Education.

The policies that govern the school are written by the school principal and faculty and are approved by the parish pastors.

An active School Board serves the administration in an advisory capacity. The School Board is comprised of the pastors (*ex officio*), the administrator, two representatives from Saint Mary's parish, and eight representatives from Saint Elizabeth's parish.

The Home and School Association (HASA) provides valuable service through fundraising and various activities. The profits are used to purchase updated textbooks, equipment and to provide assemblies for the students. HASA extends a monetary gift to each faculty member for individual classroom use. The pastors, school administration, faculty, and these school organizations continuously work together to help build a strong sense of school community.
