We pride ourselves on providing a warm, caring Catholic Christian environment where children are taught respect for others and themselves by a dedicated, experienced lay faculty, which has been certified under the Diocesan Child Protection Catechesis program.

Together a committed faculty and staff work to encourage students to be responsible for their choices and to accept the consequences of their decisions. The Second Step Program is utilized to assist faculty and students with this awareness education.

In addition to providing a strong spiritual environment, Saint Elizabeth Regional School offers a strong spiritual and academic curriculum. We are fortunate to have classes in art, computer, music, Spanish, and Physical Education enriching our curriculum. The Diocese of Allentown provides guidelines that meet the requirements of the State of Pennsylvania. We adhere to these guidelines and continuously keep our materials reviewed and updated.

Recognizing the importance of technology, Saint Elizabeth Regional School provides Internet access in each classroom where teachers help students explore the world in which they live using a broad database of video clips through a subscription service, *unitedstreaming*. A supervised, updated computer lab, which contains an interactive whiteboard and facilities for video conferencing, allows students to enhance their learning and research skills. A computer instructor provides weekly computer classes for all students in kindergarten through grade eight.

Saint Elizabeth Regional School is proud of the dedicated volunteers who support the educational, nutritional, and physical development of the students.

A well-organized Food Service Director provides a nutritious lunch program. Daily balanced meals are provided to the students and staff. A wellness committee has been established to assist in implementing the new PA state nutritional guidelines
