Tuition & Fees (2011 – 2012)

Tuition rates are set by the pastors of Saint Elizabeth of Hungary, Annunciation BVM – St. Mary, St. John the Baptist, SS Peter and Paul and Immaculate Conception Parishes and announced in May. Parishioners are afforded one rate, while non-parishioners rates are slightly higher. Rates usually increase from \$50 - \$100 each year.

Tuition Payment Plan Options

- Annually – Payment due August 31st; 2% discount if paid by that date
- Bi-Annually – 1st payment due August 31st – 2nd payment due December 31st – 1% discount if paid by 12/31
- *Quarterly – Payments due: August 31st, October 31st, January 31st, April 30th
- *Monthly – Ten payments – from August through April; due on the 5th or the 20th of each month
- Final payment on each plan – due in April

* Monthly and quarterly payments are collected through the First Star Savings Bank Tuition Program. Applications are available from the school office.

Fees

Each family must participate in the Shoppe E's Gift Card Program. By purchasing \$4000 worth of certificates, you will receive \$200 credit. A family's total purchase is multiplied by 5% to determine the amount of credit. If you do not meet the criteria, you will be billed for the amount owed. Any purchases made above \$4000 will be credited to your tuition for the upcoming year at a rate of 4%.

Financial Aid

Financial Aid is available through the *Eastern Pennsylvania Scholarship Foundation*. No set amount is given; allocations vary from year to year. *Applications are sent out to families in March and must be returned to the school office by mid April*. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Single parent with one child – income should not exceed \$50K;
- Household with two parents, and one child – combined income of \$60K
- Household of two parents and two children – combined income of \$70K

Students who transfer in from public schools are offered financial assistance through *CEO America*. Family income must not exceed \$50,000 and scholarships are offered for one year on an as needed basis. Requests must be received at the CEO America office by May 31st. Fundraising
