PREP (CCD) Parish Religious Education Program

Dear Parents,

Enclosed are the registration and contract forms for the 2021-2022 PREP year. Please read carefully and complete all sections of the registration form. Take time to read, discuss, and sign the contract with your child. Return all forms as soon as possible to the parish office. A copy of your child's baptismal certificate should accompany the registration unless it has already been provided. A copy is not necessary if your child has been baptized at Saint Elizabeth's.

If registrations are received by August 30, the registration fee is \$80 per child or \$140 for a family (two or more children). All registrations received after that date will be \$90 per child with no family discount. Please contact me in advance if there are any financial difficulties so we can work out a plan together.

Religious Education classes will begin with an opening Mass on Monday, September 13 at 6:00 PM. Students should first come to the parish hall for attendance and then we will proceed to church together. Parents are asked to go directly to church. **After Mass**, all students and parents should report to the parish hall for a short orientation meeting, meet the catechist and receive your Religion book. ***You will be given pertinent information including our yearly class schedule that evening. Please make every effort to attend.***

On Monday, September 20 we will have our first class. We begin in the parish hall at 6:00 PM each week. (Doors open at 5:45 PM.) Students should come **promptly** to the parish hall by 6:00 PM. We will begin with opening prayers and dismissal to the classrooms. All students will be dismissed at 7:30 PM. Parents of students in grades K – 4 should come into the school building to pick up their children at 7:30 PM –dismissal time.
