Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

SOLEMNITY OF MARY, MOTHER OF GOD

A Holy Day of Obligation. The title "Mother of God" is a western derivation from the Greek Theotokos, which means "God-bearer". The Solemnity of Mary Mother of God is celebrated on January 1st and is a Holy Day of Obligation; meaning Catholics must attend Mass except for illness. In the Bible, this is noted, when Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth she says: "Blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And why has this happened to me, that the mother of my Lord comes to me?" *Lk 1:39-45*

PRAYER, ADORATION AND ROSARY

Adoration is held one hour before every weekday Mass. We also say the rosary half an hour before Mass begins. Please join us. The main church is open daily from 10 am to 2 pm for private prayer.

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

Jacob's favorite son was sold into slavery by his jealous brothers. That Joseph became the powerful steward of the Pharaohs resources in the land of Egypt. This Joseph, the husband of Mary served as the steward of his household and brought them to Egypt to care for and protect them. In caring for his foster son, he was managing the most precious resource in salvation history. Jesus was nurtured in Joseph's household. Jesus was protected by this journey from the jealous murder by Herod of all potential rivals to his kingship.

Upon Herod's death, Joseph returned with his family to the land of Israel as directed by the angel. Herod's son was ruling the area of Judea. The holy family settled in Galilee in the town of Nazareth. This would fulfill the prophecy: "He shall be called a Nazorean."

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD – HOUSE BLESSING

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Epiphany.

The blessing of homes, on whose lintels are inscribed with blessed chalk the Cross of salvation, together with the indication of the year and the initials of the three wise men (20+C+M+B+26), Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar which can also be interpreted to mean Christus Mansionem Benedicat, (Christ Bless this House) written in blessed chalk. This custom, often accompanied by processions of children with their parents, expresses the blessing of Christ through the intercession of the three wise men and is an occasion for gathering offerings for charitable and missionary purposes. We will have house blessing packets available at all the exits of the church on the weekend of the Epiphany, Jan 6th. Packets will be available starting December 31st in the church.
