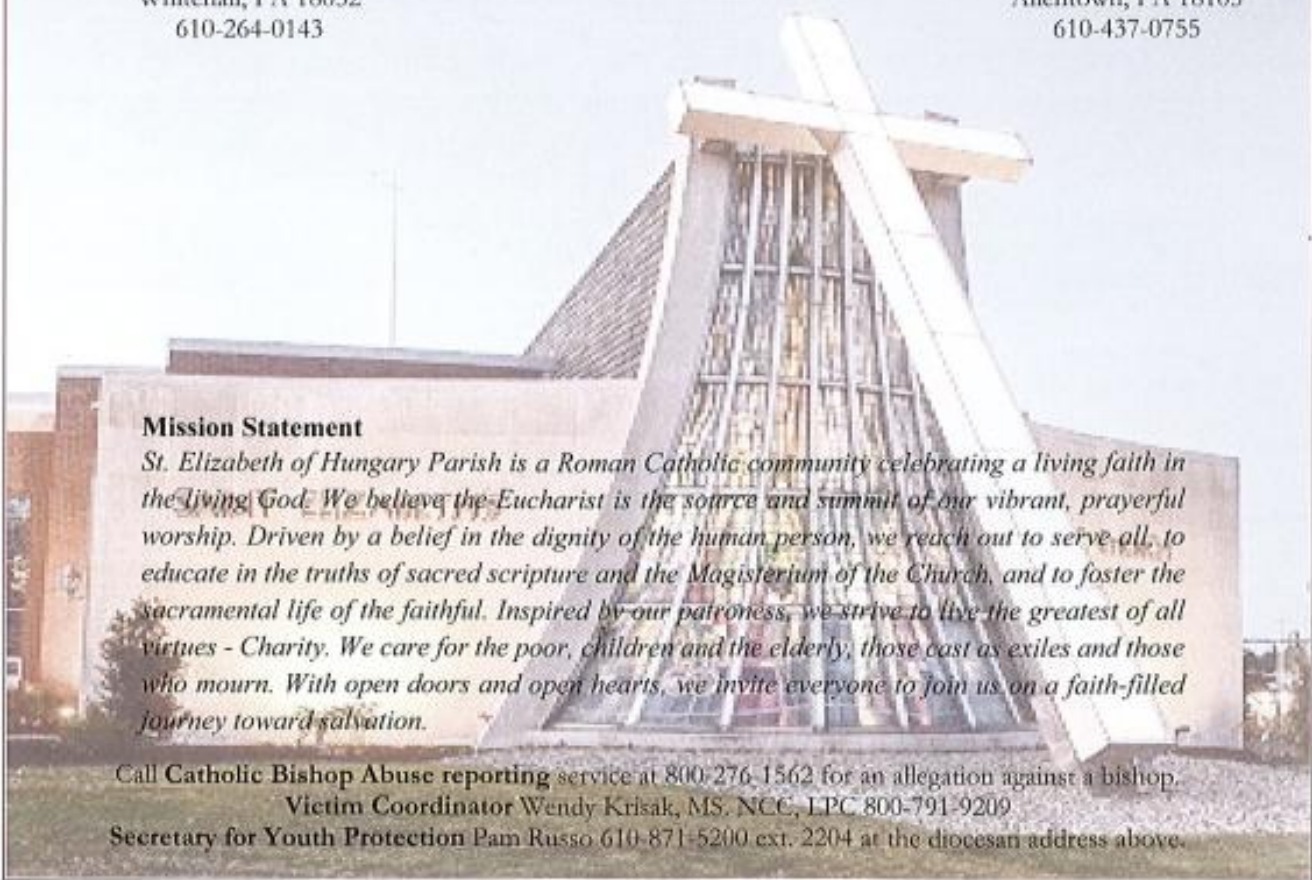

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

In the gospel, John the Baptist says, “Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world.” John attests to a profound reality. The Messiah comes not with great armies and power. Jesus comes as the sacrificial lamb, offering His whole life that sins might be forgiven.

Sin is a failure to love. God has given His love, and we turn our back on Him. To say, “I have sinned” is to recognize not that I have broken a commandment but that I have broken a promise, I am a broken person and have nailed Him to the cross. Sin is a failure to care and a failure to love. Sin breaks hearts, not only the heart of Jesus, but the heart of the person you have sinned against and in truth one’s own heart.

To sin is not to do something. Sin is a failure to do something. We are called to love. We are made in the image and likeness of God. We are made to love.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact the Pastor at the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; this is the preferred contact method, please do not pass messages through others.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

OLD PALM COLLECTION

You may bring your old palms to church anytime from now to February 6th for us to dispose of properly. The underlying idea is that what has been dedicated to God should be returned to God, in a sense, the same way a person's dead body is committed to the earth. Never should one just "throw out" what has been dedicated to God. The normal "rule of thumb" is that anything that has been blessed should be burned, if possible, (and then the ashes buried) or if not burned simply buried.

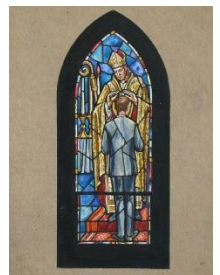
CONFIRMATION PRAYER PARTNERS
