Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

ST. ELIZABETH CHURCH HISTORY

This year we will highlight a Saint depicted on our stained-glass window each month. In July we have Sr. Mother McAuley.

An informational pamphlet was placed on her window shelf. The information will also be posted to the church website under Parish History for those interested.

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

Friday is the memorial of St. Benedict. His sister, by tradition his twin sister, is St. Scholastica. Remember you and your siblings are called to be saints. Benedict had been trained and expected to follow a career in the Roman government. He was not impressed by that lifestyle. Benedict left the comfort and prestige of his home to live as a hermit.

Benedict introduced a whole new dynamic to what it meant to be a monastic. As the father of western monasticism, his rule was about community not about being a hermit.

It can be described as: Seeking God not material things; Concern for the common good rather than individualism; Commitment as opposed to non-involvement (a cathedral takes forever to build since it is built forever); Sharing in community instead of competition; Hospitality instead of exclusion and rejection; Care for the earth not exploitation of resources; Peace not violence (peace is what we are made for even as we discover our own tendencies to violence).

Exercise these virtues to grow in holiness. You have one week.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

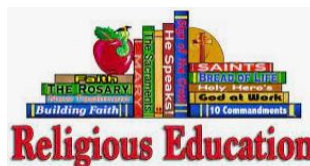

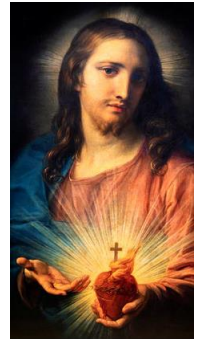

CHURCH BUILDING HOUSEKEEPING

The main church carpet – Many of you have pointed out that that church carpet has developed ‘wrinkles’. We are aware and have discussed it with our carpet expert who tells us that the carpet was laid with glue and stretching it would break down the integrity of the carpet. In a recent inspection by Catholic Mutual Association, the diocesan insurance company, St. Elizabeth was cited for these wrinkles as a safety hazard and were given six months to rectify the issue.

Therefore, we are speaking with Mascari International Carpets & Rugs, a St. Elizabeth parishioner, to determine the best course of action. We may potentially have to replace the entire carpet for safety as well as aesthetics.



The main church roof – For those who might not have noticed in the last month during the extremely heavy rains that the Lehigh Valley was subjected to our church roof developed a leak. On the East side near the ceiling. We had buckets out, the area was roped off and we had plastic down to prevent mold. We are awaiting final inspections of the roof to determine if we can repair that section and delay replacing the entire roof until we have additional funds available for this project. To date we have collected \$9,500 from generous parishioners to replace the roof when needed. Thank you very much.

The main church confessionals – Over the last few weeks we have begun the Confessional reconfiguration as outlined by the diocese last year. The diocese issued a plan to remodel church confessionals so that the previous direct face to face penitent and confessor will no longer be the standard. This is for the protection of the confessor and the penitent as the potential for physical contact has been removed. The confessor will now be on one side of the full wall with a screen for communication with the penitent on the other side of the full wall. A chair and kneeler will still be available for the penitent’s seating or kneeling preference. The confessionals are exactly the same dimensions as they were, although the appearance of them being smaller is an optical illusion due to the full wall now in place. Carpeting will be replaced in the confessionals when the main church carpet is done. There will now be two confessionals where previously there were three. Please use the door at either side, the middle door is for the confessor’s use.

During holidays and sacramental services, the additional white screen partitions will still be used with a chair for the confessor and a chair for the penitent in a potential face to face manner. We are accommodating the diocesan preference for weekly confession in the existing confessionals and hope that people can understand the need for overflow confessional areas during holidays and sacramental services. Thank you.
