### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation** (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

### WRITINGS FROM DEACON

In the immortal words of James Carville advising Bill Clinton “It’s the economy, stupid!” From time to time we may wonder about the word order to more appropriately be expressed “It’s the stupid economy.” We may find ourselves bogged down in understanding the concept more in terms of taxes, tariffs and interest rates. More correctly the word derives from two Greek words [oikos] or house and [nemein] to manage.

Divine economy considers God’s plan and action in the world of salvation and redemption. In the Catechism of the Catholic Church {258}, the divine economy is the common work of the three divine persons. The Trinity has only one and the same nature, so too, one and the same operation. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit are not three principles but one principle. Each divine person performs common work according to his unique personal property. The Church confesses, following the New Testament, “one God and Father *from* whom all things are, one Lord Jesus Christ, *through* whom all things are, and one Holy Spirit *in* whom all things are.” It is above all the divine missions of the Son’s Incarnation and the gift of the Holy Spirit that show forth the properties of the divine persons.

Being a work at once common and personal, the whole divine economy makes known both what is proper to the divine persons and their one divine nature. Everyone who glorifies the Father does so through the Son in the Holy Spirit; everyone who follows Christ does so because the Father draws him and the Spirit moves him.

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### **BAPTISM:** *(Infant to Age 6)*

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### **FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:**

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### **CONFIRMATION:**

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### **MARRIAGE:**

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### **PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:**

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

### **FUNERAL:**

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

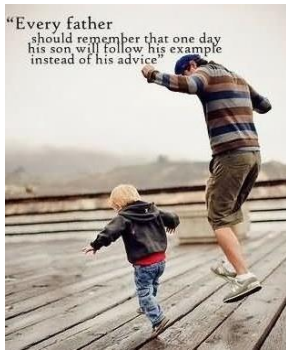
