Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

ST. ELIZABETH CHURCH HISTORY

This year we will highlight a Saint depicted on our stained-glass window each month. In May we have St. Martha.

An informational pamphlet was placed on her window shelf. The information will also be posted to the church website under Parish History for those interested.

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

In today's first reading from Genesis, the passage concludes with Abram giving a tenth of everything – a tithe. The priest of God Most High brought out bread and wine. In the Offertory, we bring forth our tithe and our gifts of bread and wine. The name Melchizedek means King of Justice. He is described as the King of Salem. Salem derives from "shalom" meaning peace, completeness, perfection and wholeness. In the *ordinary* priesthood of the baptized, united with Christ, we bring forth our gifts with and in Christ the high priest. By the *ministerial* priesthood, these gifts are consecrated and become the Body and Blood of Christ.

Jesus, who is priest and sacrifice offers himself to the Father to reconcile and restore us to the dignity which had been intended for us from the beginning. Christ, who is peace, wholeness, completeness and perfection imparts to us by his mercy the undeserved satisfaction of justice to which we were liable.

In the Gospel today, so many people sought to hear the teaching of Jesus. A great many of them needed healing. So strong was their intention that they followed to a rather remote place. The apostles considered the general welfare of the people and asked Jesus to send them away to forage and to rest.

Jesus told the apostles to feed the crowd themselves. Realizing that they had only a little bread and a few fish, the apostles pretty much resigned themselves to failure. The resulting miracle reminds us of two things: the power of God; and nobody likes fish sandwiches.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.
