### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation** (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

### ST. ELIZABETH CHURCH HISTORY

This year we will highlight a Saint depicted on our stained-glass window each month. In May we have St. Martha.

An informational pamphlet was placed on her window shelf. The information will also be posted to the church website under Parish History for those interested.

### WRITINGS FROM DEACON

On Thursday, we celebrate the feast of St. Thomas the Apostle. He was pragmatic and practical. When the other disciples had told him that Jesus had risen from the dead, Thomas did not immediately accept their word. He has been described as doubting. He knew all that Jesus had promised. He knew that suffering was part of what it meant to be a follower of Christ.

Jesus had appeared to the other disciples while Thomas was not present. Thomas stipulated to the others that he would not believe unless he touched the wounds and placed his hand in Jesus' side. Jesus returned when Thomas was there and invited him to experience the wound just as he said.

Jesus said to Thomas, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Perhaps seeing was believing for Thomas. It could be that seeing Jesus is less important than for Jesus to touch our wounds.

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### **BAPTISM:** (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### **FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:**

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### **CONFIRMATION:**

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### **MARRIAGE:**

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### **PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:**

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

### **FUNERAL:**

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.
