### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation** (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

## WRITINGS FROM DEACON

It was so rainy last month. There must have been about twenty days of rain ... well ... nineteen. We have finally gotten a break with a few days of sun. I had to do a frantic search for my sunglasses, having almost forgotten which drawer they were in. There they were right next to a forgotten Borders Bookstore gift card. That card would be nearly useless now. I saw an item in “2<sup>nd</sup> and Charles” a couple of years ago that could be used to punch out guitar picks from old credit cards and gift cards. Maybe there is hope for my Borders card.

Today we celebrate Pentecost, the birthday of the Church, the Holy Spirit poured out upon the disciples. We can use this time to reflect upon the sevenfold gifts of the Holy Spirit ... that list from Isaiah 11 which we diligently memorized for our confirmation. What of them? What about wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety? What of fear of the Lord? At this time ... TODAY... let us ask the Holy Spirit to lead us TODAY to that gift which we are to be intentionally exercising for this moment or for this week. May we be changed by that experience. May we be drawn to successive encounters of grace with the other gifts.

These gifts do not become expired or void. We shouldn't lose them in a drawer.

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

### FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

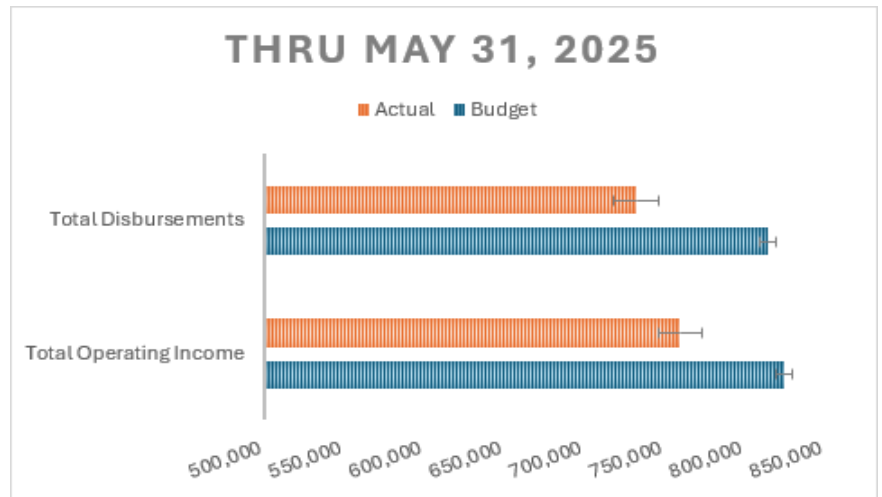

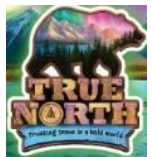
