Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

ST. ELIZABETH CHURCH HISTORY

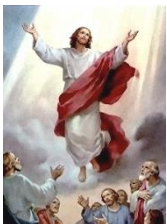
This year we will highlight a Saint depicted on our stained-glass window each month. In May we have St. Kateri Tekakwitha.

ASCENSION THURSDAY – HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION, MAY 29TH



Forty days after His resurrection from the dead, Christ ascended into heaven. Christ's ascension marks the definitive entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly domain. Jesus, as the head of the Church, preceded us into the Father's glorious kingdom so that we, the members of His Body, may live in the hope of one day being with Him forever. Jesus Christ, having entered the sanctuary of heaven once and for all intercedes constantly

for us as the mediator who assures us of the permanent outpouring of the Holy Spirit. (*Catechism of the Catholic Church 665-667*)

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

On Thursday, the church honors St. Rita of Cascia. She is the patron saint of desperate situations. She was married at a young age to a rather impious, unfaithful and cruel man. They had two sons. In time, her husband, who had been in a family feud, came around to a gentler disposition. The other family brutally murdered her husband. At her husband's funeral, Rita expressed forgiveness for those who had done such evil. Her husband's brother desired to avenge his death and took her sons to train to exact justice against the other family. Rita tried to convince her sons not to do this evil. She pleaded with them to preserve their souls. They were not convinced. In one year, they were taken by natural causes through dysentery. This preserved them from the sin that they had intended. The brother was infected by the plague, and he gave up the family vendetta also.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

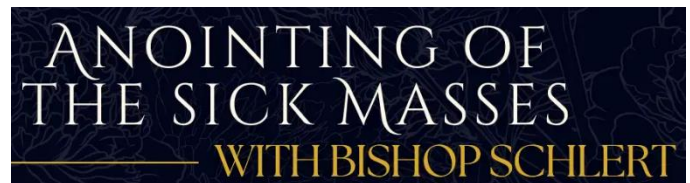
