Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for ‘Certificate of Eligibility’ are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

It is just about time for cookout season to begin. Most of us have found gas grills to be convenient and effective. It is usually not difficult to control the intensity of the heat by adjusting the flame with a simple nudge of the valve.

Some prefer the flavor and character imparted using charcoal. This has been the standard for so long. A great deal more patience is required for using this method. It may take as long as 40 minutes for the coals to come to heat. Then adjusting grill height and air flow is so much more involved in order to control the heat and intensity.

How many times is charcoal mentioned in the Bible? Three times! In Proverbs 26:21 “Charcoal for coals, wood for fire - such are the quarrelsome enkindling strife.”

In John’s passion narrative, Peter was warming himself by a charcoal fire when he denied the Lord three times.

In today’s gospel reading, also from John, the disciples saw a charcoal fire with fish on it and bread. What follows is the invitation for Peter to three times *affirm* his love for Jesus. He of course does and is invited and commissioned to then feed and tend the lambs and the sheep of his flock.

Something to consider on the back deck this summer: One might consider charcoal to be a source of conflict and quarrel. ... charcoal may be a focus for denial and rejection. ... charcoal may be a reminder to renew our commitment to the Lord.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

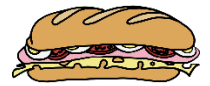

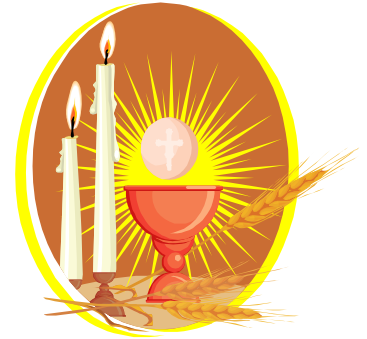
