### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation** (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

## ST. ELIZABETH CHURCH HISTORY

This year we will highlight a Saint depicted on our stained-glass window each month. In November we have our patron St. Elizabeth of Hungary. An informational pamphlet was placed on his window shelf. The information will also be posted to the church website under Parish History for those interested.

## WRITINGS FROM DEACON

We are one body in Christ. The Mystical Body of Christ is understood as the Church Triumphant (the saints in heaven), the Church Militant (those who struggle to love and to be holy), and the Church Suffering (those in purgatory). Our only point of reference is our existence in this life on earth. We deal with challenges to holiness and purity, prominently health and wealth to varying degrees of abundance or deficit. This is all in the backdrop of time.

At the point of our natural death, time is no longer a factor. We come before the Lord for judgement knowing nothing unholy can enter heaven. The options are reward or punishment. If we are judged to merit heaven by the grace and mercy of God, through sacrifice and service, cleansing can happen; others may have to follow judgement.

We are in this together. We pray with the saints in heaven for various requests. We pray for the souls in purgatory as we pray for our friends and family. We should also pray for those who have no one to pray for them. "What you do for these least ones, you do for me."



## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

### FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

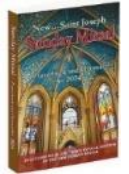


### MUSIC MINISTRY NUTROLL SALE

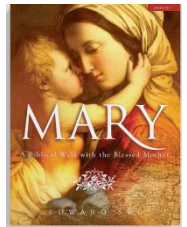
