### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation** (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

### ST. ELIZABETH CHURCH HISTORY

This year we will highlight a Saint depicted on our stained-glass window each month. In October we have St. Martin de Porres. An informational pamphlet was placed on his window shelf. The information will also be posted to the church website under Parish History for those interested.

### WRITINGS FROM DEACON

In Luke, Jesus offers a parable describing a dishonest judge (yes, it is a parable) who was unwilling to render a verdict favorable to a widow in the town. He simply made no decision in the matter at all. The widow remained persistent in her request. The judge was moved to rule in her favor not as much by the merits of her case but because of her persistence. The judge was described as not respecting God or anyone.

Jesus reminds us that God is not like that. God highly favors His chosen ones and hears their call. The value of persistence in prayer and faith is stressed here. God will not be slow in responding to their pleas and their prayers.

In Exodus, it is described how Moses prayed during the battle. We are reminded of some of the postures we use as we celebrate Mass. Kneeling is a posture of adoration. Standing is a posture of prayer. Sitting is a posture of listening and attention. Besides persistence in prayer, the support in prayer by Aaron and Hur is described. They placed a rock for Moses to sit on, and they supported his hands. We support one another in our prayer while the priest has his hands raised.

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### **BAPTISM:** (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### **FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:**

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### **CONFIRMATION:**

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### **MARRIAGE:**

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### **PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:**

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

### **FUNERAL:**

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.
