Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

ST. ELIZABETH CHURCH HISTORY

This year we will highlight a Saint depicted on our stained-glass window each month. In September we have St. Jude Thaddeus. An informational pamphlet was placed on his window shelf. The information will also be posted to the church website under Parish History for those interested.

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

In today’s gospel, we hear a parable of a rich man. There is also a poor person named Lazarus who lingered at the rich man’s door. The poor man was hungry and had many sores. Lazarus was very easy to avoid and to walk around. When the poor man died, he was taken to the bosom of Abraham.

The rich man also died and arrived in a place of torment. He sought some remedy by appealing to Abraham for mercy. When he denied that for himself, he asked for some warning and protection for his brothers. Abraham answered that Moses and the prophets have already given the message of warning and of consequences. The rich man insisted that if someone came from the dead, his brothers would repent.

The poor man is identified. His name is Lazarus. This rich guy, so uncaring and inattentive to the needs of one at his own doorstep is not named. Who could he be? Could he be me? Jesus would attend to the needs of Lazarus. Jesus would come to Lazarus’ aid without hesitation. In baptism, we are healed and renewed, and we are named as precious to the Father. In our baptism, we have been made rich by grace. So, we are the rich man and have been given a name. Jesus rose from the dead. He has reminded us of our identity and dignity and of what we need to do.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.
