## DEACON'S WRITING

In our baptism we are joined to Jesus in His death. We die to self and we enter into life as a new creation sharing in a life of grace. A promise of eternal life is offered. The suffering sacrifice of Our Lord has been described in such brutal detail. This death was our sentence. Our sinfulness brought about judgement. We deserve to suffer and die in this way. If I am a mass murderer, if I offer a mild insult, if I harbor envious thoughts toward something pertaining to my neighbor, if I am casual about my relationship with God ... I have broken the whole of my covenant with God. It is not my estimate of approximate compliance with His commandment which matters. It is not relative obedience that is judged as complete faithfulness.

What penalty do I deserve? Justice demands death. In His Mercy, God has sent His Son. Jesus has paid the penalty. He has posted ransom. We are joined in His death. We share in His resurrection. His empty tomb is the promise that death is not the final word. It wasn't for Jesus and is not for us when we live united to Him.

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

**Contact the Pastor at the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick;** this is the preferred contact method, please do not pass messages through others.

### FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

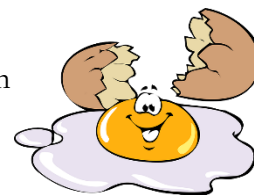
## NIGHT AT THE RACES
