LENTEN INTERESTING FACTS

The 40 days of Lent are based on periods of trial and testing. In the New Testament, we find the number 40 is significant in the life of Jesus: Jesus fasted 40 days and nights, was tempted 40 days by Satan, and remained on earth 40 days after the Resurrection. Because of this, “by the solemn 40 days of Lent, the Church unites herself to the mystery of Jesus in the desert.”



DEACON WRITING

As prelude to today’s gospel, Peter had declared that Jesus was the Messiah, “You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.” Jesus clarified to Peter and to the others that being the Messiah was not going to look like a warrior king conqueror destroying political oppressors. In God’s plan, the faith leaders would indict, try, torture and condemn. The political leaders would then conduct his execution. This was just not what the people were expecting from all that they had ever heard about the expected Messiah. Jesus said that anyone who wished to be his follower would prepare to experience oppression and even death. In the Transfiguration, the transcendent glory of God is revealed affirming hope and confidence in God’s faithfulness and triumph.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member’s enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact the Pastor at the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; this is the preferred contact method, please do not pass messages through others.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

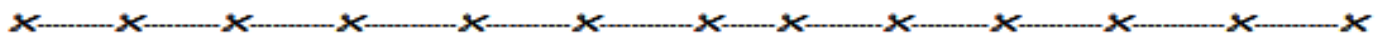
