DEACON WRITING

The Samaritan woman at the well was sometimes assumed to be a sinner. Certainly, she was marginalized and an outcast. Societal circumstances may have had an impact on her situation. Jews did not willingly associate with Samaritans. Samaritans were considered to be compromised in their faith through consequences of their captivity and exile. Samaritan women had no means or resources apart from their husbands; details why she came to be married several times are not described.

She was a seeker of truth. She was aware that her ancestors worshipped in the place where she conversed with Jesus and that Jews worshipped in Jerusalem. Jesus' answers hinted and then confirmed that He was the Messiah.

Enthusiastically, she abandoned her water jar and went into the town. She was carrying within her a font of water springing up to eternal life. She excitedly shared what she had found.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact the Pastor at the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; this is the preferred contact method, please do not pass messages through others.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.
