DEACON'S WRITING

Two people went out for a walk. They were heading towards East Penn Diner not far at all from the Way to Emmaus. It was a seven-mile trip taking maybe three hours depending upon terrain and how intent they were at walking instead of talking. They were quite distressed by some things that they had seen and experienced in the past few days. Their situations were just not quite gelling with their expectations. Disappointment, confusion and sadness seemed to dominate their discussion. Some other person met up with them and walked along with them.

Sometimes we just don't realize how close Jesus is to us. How often do we fail to recognize His presence? He is closer to us than we are to ourselves. He feels what we feel. His care is always with us. Christ comes to us in our neighbor. At times He ministers to us in our concerns. Other times we minister to Him in "the least of our brothers" in their need and suffering. May we see Christ with the eyes of Christ. May we see Christ revealed in all of scripture.

May we recognize Him in the breaking of the bread and be filled by Him.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact the Pastor at the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; this is the preferred contact method, please do not pass messages through others.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

PARISH UPDATES

To Answer some of the questions from the Feasibility Survey Why do the church roof now? How can we pay for it?

The roof was in critical failure. We are using church reserves to pay for it with the intention of replenishing the reserves with donations coming in over the next year.

The asbestos in the school has been encapsulated and safe for decades however four years ago the diocese had an inspection done of all schools to determine the level of asbestos still present. After evaluation several schools in the diocese, including St Elizabeth Regional School, were required to remove asbestos for environmental regulations. In 2023 the second floor of the school had the asbestos removed. In 2026 we will be removing the asbestos on the first floor and replacing all flooring in the school.

The carpet in the church visibly looks fine but it is wrinkled and an insurance hazard. The church carpet was glued down and cannot be stretched, so while the general appearance is good, we must replace it for insurance purposes.

Feasibility study was positive and comments that were given on the survey's questions are encouraging. The feasibility survey results will be posted to the church website along with capital campaign information soon.

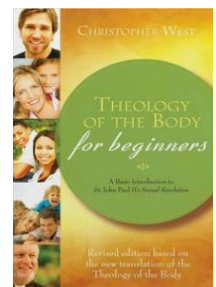
NOMINATE YOUTH FOR BISHOP'S COMMISSION
