DEACON'S WRITING

I AM the way, the truth, and the life. I AM the gate for the sheep. I AM the good shepherd. I AM the bread of life.

We usually consider a gate or a door as a passive structural element. It affords access and protection. One can enter into a place of safety and security. One can securely exit to gather what is necessary ... to participate in the marketplace as required. Then, to return to the security of the place of rest. Here Jesus tells us that He is an active and personal presence. He is the way. We will be saved. We will come in and go out and find pasture. We are protected in our coming and going by way of Him.

Jesus is the truth. He is the good shepherd. A shepherd is always a person. The shepherd is active in pasturing his sheep and in protecting them. The good shepherd does not abandon his sheep to danger. He stands always to care for his sheep. He is truth.

We can have no life without food. We rely on bread as food no matter how you slice it. Jesus is our food. He is our life. For the most part, food is a commodity. Jesus is the personal presence we encounter in the eucharist.

Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life, the gate, the shepherd, the bread of life ... the very personal God who has called us by name.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact the Pastor at the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; this is the preferred contact method, please do not pass messages through others.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

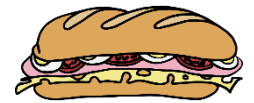
TOGETHER FOR TOMORROW RAFFLE

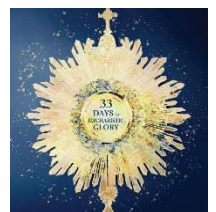
YOUTH MINISTRY – STEUBENVILLE TRIP

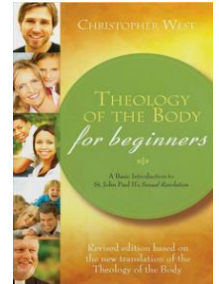
OUR BASKET SOCIAL EVENT IS 6 MONTHS AWAY!
