PRAYER, ADORATION AND ROSARY



Adoration is held one hour before every weekday Mass. We also say the rosary half an hour before Mass begins. Please join us. The main church is open daily from 10 am to 2 pm for private prayer. This month we are devoting adoration to Priestly Vocations. Please pray for the Holy Spirit to inspire more men to join the priesthood.

DEACON'S WRITING

The Oran Posture involves praying with one's hands raised and extended.

At several points in the Mass, the priest may choose to raise his hands in the Oran Posture. The symbology of actions at Mass, including gestures, reflects the sacramental character of church prayer.

In the church rubrics, when the main celebrant uses the Oran gesture it indicates that he is praying on BEHALF of the congregation acting as *alter Christus*. The posture is also for concelebrating priests particularly during the Eucharistic Prayer and for the Our Father. The Oran Posture is not done by a Deacon on the altar, *because he does not represent the people before God*, but assists the celebrant who does. Liturgical unity is a desire of the Church.

Many of the faithful choose to also use the Oran posture during their private prayer. It is not required, by the congregation, during the Liturgy of the Mass.



SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact the Pastor at the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; this is the preferred contact method, please do not pass messages through others.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a Loved one please contact the funeral home of your choice. The funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

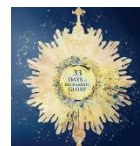
HOAGIE FUNDRAISER

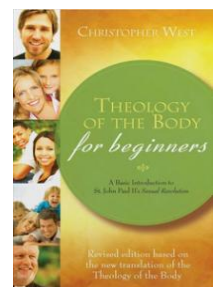
OUR BASKET SOCIAL IS 6 MONTHS AWAY!
