HOLY DAY Assumption of Mary – August 15

The Assumption is the oldest feast day of Our Lady, when Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast day turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over. Although this is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year there will be a Mass at 9:00 am on Saturday in the main church.



SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST EUCHARIST/ PENANCE:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact the Pastor at the parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick; this is the preferred contact method, please do not pass messages through others.

FUNERAL:

For the passing of a loved one, please contact the funeral home of your choice. The Funeral Director will contact the church to arrange a date and time for the service. Funerals are held on weekdays.

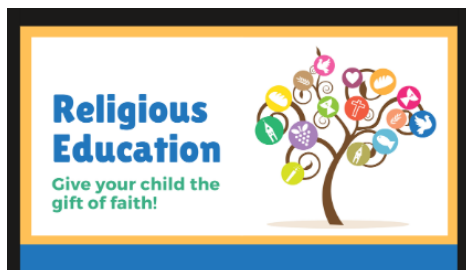

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

- The windows in the parish hall are installed. These are tinted glass and the view to outside is beautiful especially on clear sunny days.
- The entry to the parish hall is finished and much easier to use for deliveries and general ADA access. The plate glass window in the parish hall foyer was replaced for safety reason and is also tinted and looks very nice.
- A new sign was installed on the Parish Hall for visitors.
- The school asbestos was removed. The new floors on both levels of the school have been installed. New lighting has been put in place throughout the school, the classrooms and halls have been painted, and the classroom furniture & equipment should be back in place by August 14th. New insulated windows have been installed in the school to help with heating and air conditioning costs. A few of the classroom air conditioners had to be replaced. These AC units were twenty five years old.
