

FAQ - GIFT CARDS FOR EARNED TUITION CREDIT

Below is a listing of the most frequently asked questions regarding the RaiseRight Gift Cards for earned credit:

1. How do I earn Tuition Credit for Gift Cards purchases?

The profit is split between purchasers and the school. Each time a RaiseRight Gift Card is purchased, it is entered into the student account. Cards earning a higher percentage will naturally yield a higher credit. Please see the RaiseRight website for gift card percentage.

2. Can anyone purchase Gift Cards for Tuition credit?

YES!!! Encourage your family and friends to purchase RaiseRight Gift Cards for earned credit. All that is needed is for your family or friends to indicate your student's name so the credit can be applied to your account!

3. Can I donate my "credits"?

If a family opts to not receive earned credit, they may certainly donate their credits. Credits may be donated to another family in the school, ACCHS or BECA high school, or directly back to St. Elizabeth Parish or Regional School.

4. What happens if my child leaves St. Elizabeth?

If your student withdraws prior to or at the end of the program year you agree to allow distribution of any remaining earned credit funds to be distributed to benefit St. Elizabeth parish or school. Students enrolling in diocesan high schools may credit those funds toward their student's diocesan high school account.

5. Can earned credit be used for anything else?

We will use gift card credit toward outstanding balances for things such as Extended Day or other outstanding school balances.

6. I prepay my tuition. What happens to my credits?

You may choose how to apply earned credits; you may apply the credit to the current year or to the following year's tuition or donate the credit to the parish or school.
