

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



At the center of the life of the Church is Jesus. He is the foundation. He is the heart and the soul and the reason for being. And because of this truth, it also means that one act of faith lies at the heart of who we are and that is the Eucharist.

The Eucharist has a central place in our faith lives and in the life of the Church. Because we believe that when we share this meal, we are receiving God. The meal that we receive from the altar is a God-moment of the highest order; one in which God comes to us as real food. Receiving the Eucharist is not simply time to think about God, but to experience intimacy with the Divine. You could call it 'a little Heaven on Earth.'

But this holy moment of receiving the Eucharist is not meant to be just an isolated moment between God and me or God and you. The entire faith community (not just here but all around the world) share in this sacred meal because God calls us as a people, sustains us as a people, unites us as a people, saves us as a people and transforms us as a people. We are all in this together as St. Paul says, "Because the loaf of bread is one, we, though many, are one body, for we partake of the one bread."

The Body of Christ is not just something we receive from that altar. The Body of Christ is someone we become through the goodness of God, the sacrifice of His Son, and the power of the Holy Spirit.

May we never see this Holy Meal as just simply a private spiritual moment, but as a challenge to live the Gospel, not alone, but side by side.



SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

INFANT BAPTISM:

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

CONFIRMATION

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
