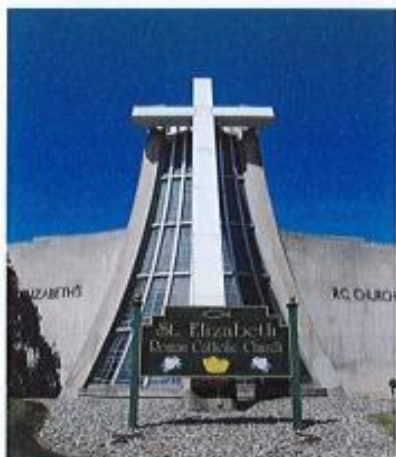

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



In the Parable of the Sower, Matthew gives us the image of a Sower scattering seed everywhere. It's important to notice that the Sower is not concerned with only sowing seed where he thinks it will grow. He sows his seeds all over the place, not really knowing which will grow and which will not, not really knowing which soil is fertile and which is not. That's not his job. That's not for him to know. That's not really in his control.

It seems like God wants us to understand that a life of faith is not about 'knowing' or 'figuring out' or being in control, but rather being a certain kind of person (a certain good soil). A life of faith is simply that - being faithful. We don't always have to see the path ahead to know what the fruits of our efforts will bring about. That's not possible, nor is it even our job.

We don't know how things will turn out when it comes to our spiritual journeys, we don't know God's plan, don't know which action will produce good fruit, don't know the effect the good we try to do will have in the grand scheme of things. And that's ok. We're not in control; we're not supposed to know. What we do know is the type of person God wants us to be. And that is in our control.

Here is an image for you. A woman sits in a factory working a machine that makes a certain kind of bolt. This person does the best she can to make this one part the way it needs to be made. The work isn't glamorous. It can be routine and monotonous. But every day she does her best to make that bolt right. A year later a Boeing 777 rolls out of a distant factory, this beautiful creation of hundreds of thousands of parts - each made by someone far away, someone who had no idea of the complete design, no idea what parts thousands of others were contributing. Each person did one small thing well and the result was beautiful.

Faith is like that. We don't have to know the big picture. All we must do is try our best in this time and place. We just need to be faithful people. We need to be kind, compassionate, generous, forgiving, and loving. We just need to be both good soil, and a good Sower, sowing seeds of God's great love all over the place. God will do the rest. And we really don't have to know how it's all going to turn out. God knows, and that should be good enough for us.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

INFANT BAPTISM:

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

CONFIRMATION

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
