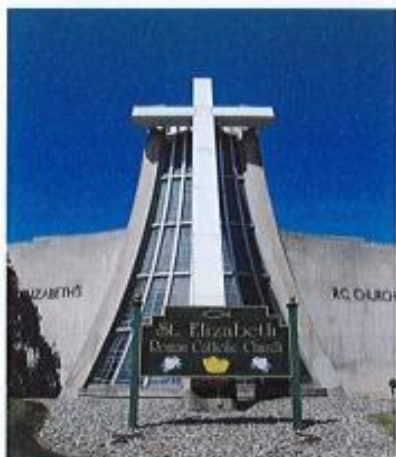

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



There are a number of lessons to take from today's readings. The first is the need for total trust and confidence and faith that Jesus really does care for us, in spite of what we might see as indications to the contrary. The second is the need for us to persist in prayer. This does not always result in getting what we have asked for. Persistent prayer helps us to see more clearly what God wants for us, and what is really best for us. Finally, today's gospel is an affirmation that God's love and mercy are extended to all who call on him in faith and trust, no matter who they are or where they are.

In the divine scheme of things, the more we lose, the more we win. The more we give, the more we receive. The more we go down, the higher we will

ascend. Ask anyone who has ever successfully completed a recovery program, they will tell you that you find power over whatever beset you when you surrender to your Higher Power.

God came among us with healing power, and He is looking for our faith. The Canaanite woman came to God in faith and in search of healing and found it. Remember the Roman Centurian who came to Jesus for help to cure his servant. In our brokenness, we come before our God, in faith and love, to ask for His healing. We trust in Him and as we gaze upon our Lord present in the Eucharist, may we humbly pray 'Lord, I am not worthy, but only say the word and I too shall be healed'.

When calling the parish during office hours from nine in the morning until three in the afternoon please use 610-266-0695.

After office hours or in an emergency please call the number above and press extension 310 to leave a message. The pastor will return your call as soon as possible.

Anointing of the Sick previously known as "Extreme Unction or Last Rites" will bring comfort to your loved one and the sacrament may be given multiple times.

Due to HIPAA laws please have a family member call the parish to let us know your name and your location if you would like a visit from a priest.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

This is a process for welcoming new members into the Catholic Church.

Classes are on Tuesdays and start Tuesday, September 12 at 7 PM

RCIA is for: Adults (18 years or older) who are:

- Not Baptized.
- Baptized in another Christian faith and interested in learning more about the Catholic faith.
- Baptized into the Catholic faith but have not received First Eucharist or Confirmation.
- Wish to learn more about the Catholic faith.

What is the RCIA?

RCIA is a direct result of Vatican II, which called for a revival of the Adult Catechumenate. This goes back to the early traditions of the church where the Apostles welcomed newcomers into the community of faith. RCIA is the way all our Catholic communities throughout the world will be initiating newcomers into the Catholic church.

Note: Four out of five individuals who investigate the Catholic community do so because friends, relatives or neighbors extend personal invitations. Spread the good news by inviting someone!

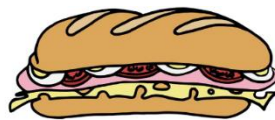

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

INFANT BAPTISM:

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

CONFIRMATION

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
