

#### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office, Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

#### Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) - Saturday 3:30 - 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism - First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage - Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick - Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



When Jesus calls Peter Satan, He does so because Peter is trying to paint a picture of a Messiah that he wants Him to be, one of this world, and not beyond. In a way it's like telling Jesus that Peter will prevent His suffering and death by protecting Him. But in doing so, he's preventing Jesus from doing the Father's will.

Jeremiah knew the feeling of being disappointed. He too was not looking at things as God does, but as human beings do. Jeremiah is crying out to God in crisis. He was compelled to preach the word of God. He could not help but preach what God wanted. But Jeremiah expected the people to listen to him, to understand him, and to change their ways, but he was mocked and ridiculed by the people. He didn't understand what God was doing in his life.

We don't always recognize with the eyes of faith the love of God at work in our lives. To spend hundreds of thousands of dollars on a child to raise, feed, clothe, and educate only to have them move out after twenty years or so with no hope of recovering your time and money seems like a lousy investment by human standards, but with eyes of faith it corresponds to priceless love. To

someone who works with the handicapped that may never be able to overcome their limitations; it seems like a waste of time by human standards, but with eyes of faith, that time spent is more precious than any treasure on earth. To die on a cross is by no means a standard for success for anyone, yet alone God, but with eyes of faith, by offering His life for our sins shows the total sacrifice of His love for us.

Following Christ is not an escape from the pain of life, it is the discovery of how to deal with it. When faith meets reality, religion can be the force that changes the world for us.

Peter's trust in God helps him pick himself up when he fails and when he gets things wrong, he doesn't give up. He perseveres in working for Christ.

We all have our own failings. We fail to understand God's purpose. But we must never fail to trust and persevere in prayer and to seek forgiveness and to allow the greatness of God's work shine through even such unworthy servants as ourselves. Everything is possible with eyes of faith.



#### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

This is a process for welcoming new members into the Catholic Church. Classes are on Tuesdays and start Tuesday, September 12 at 7 PM **RCIA** is for: Adults (18 years or older) who are:

- Not Baptized.
- Baptized in another Christian faith and interested in learning more about the Catholic faith.
- Baptized into the Catholic faith but have not received First Eucharist or Confirmation.
- Wish to learn more about the Catholic faith.

#### What is the RCIA?

RCIA is a direct result of Vatican II, which called for a revival of the Adult Catechumenate. This goes back to the early traditions of the church where the Apostles welcomed newcomers into the community of faith. RCIA is the way all our Catholic communities throughout the world will be initiating newcomers into the Catholic church.

**Note:** Four out of five individuals who investigate the Catholic community do so because friends, relatives or neighbors extend personal invitations. Spread the good news by inviting someone!

# **SACRAMENTS**

New to the parish? — Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

#### **INFANT BAPTISM:**

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

#### FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

#### **CONFIRMATION**

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

#### MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

#### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
