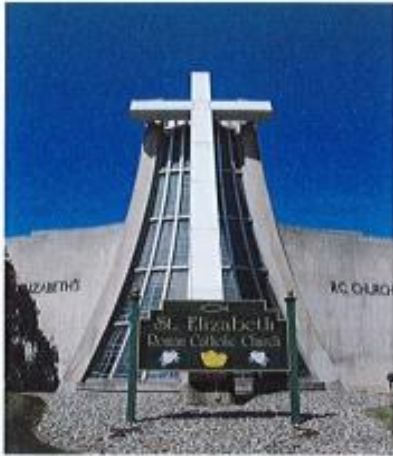

### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation (Confession)** – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Today's gospel is simple. One son tells his dad he'll work in his vineyard but doesn't. The other son says he won't work in the vineyard but changes his mind and goes to work as his father asked. Jesus of course, in his telling of the story, affirms the second son. No surprise there. Which son are we?

Many of us believe (somewhat falsely, I think) that a truly holy life, a faithful life, a God-centered life, is a life in which we get nearly everything right. Very few mistakes. Few missteps. Few moral failings. Few sins. And maybe there is a little bit of truth in that. I don't want to minimize the importance of doing the right thing day in and day out. That really wouldn't make much sense.

However, I would argue that a person of deep and authentic faith is not one who is convinced that he or she is living a life substantially pleasing to God. Rather, a truly holy person, a truly faithful person is someone who continually recognizes their own need for conversion, their own need for transformation, their own need to be more, to love more and to give more. A faithful person is one who never really feels they have reached the finish line - but always has more to go - and more to be.

A life of faith is not about remaining the same. It's about being created anew each day. In a word, it's about change - the kind of change brought about and founded on the realization that each of us can be and should be more than we were yesterday. It's never too late.

You don't like what you said to someone yesterday? Say something kinder today.

You don't like how you treated someone yesterday? Treat them better today.

You don't like the resentment you felt yesterday? Find goodness in that person today.

You turned your back on someone in need yesterday? Reach out to someone today.

You said no to something God asked of you? Say yes... today and every day.

Change. Not something to fear. Not something to dread. Rather, a gift from God that we would be wise to embrace.

One son said yes but didn't follow through. One son said no but had the courage to change his mind - and faithfully chose to get on board with what his father had asked of him.

Doesn't sound like much but it adds up quickly!

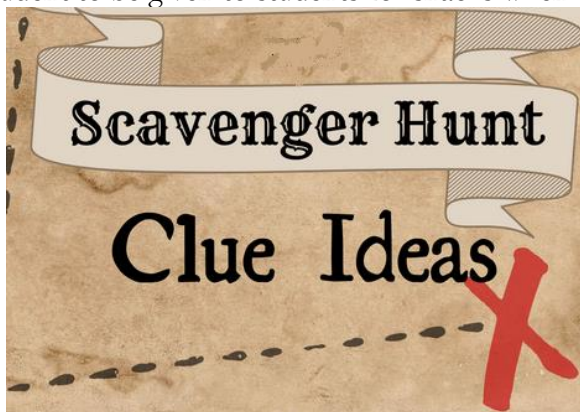

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### INFANT BAPTISM:

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

### CONFIRMATION

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

### MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
