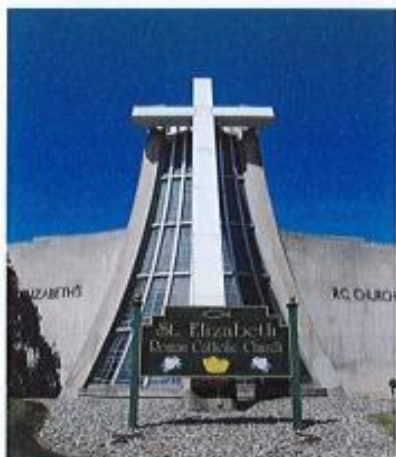

### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation** (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Today's Gospel comes from the 18<sup>th</sup> Chapter of St. Matthew and is sometimes called the Community Rule Book. It gives instruction on how people within the family of the church should relate to one another. In our passage today, we hear Jesus' instruction on how to deal with conflict within the community.

When we hear phrases like 'tough love' or 'speak the truth with love', they reflect an important fact. Being a Christian is not the same as just being nice. Peace by itself is not always the highest value there is. Injustice and wrongdoing have to be actively named and opposed, not simply ignored or wished away. That is why justice and peace are linked together; because without justice, there can be no real peace; only appeasement and compromise which can simply be ways to allow evil to triumph.

Jesus has so much love and compassion for every single person. He simply will not stand idly by and watch a person cause pain and heartache to themselves and others, to fall short of their potential and worst of all, to spend eternity in hell.

This is why Jesus came here in the first place, to save mankind from the pain of sin and to reconcile ourselves to God. And that is why we are commanded to confront sin and to help people change their destructive ways (e.g., drug abuse, violence, discrimination, exploitation, immoral behavior). This requires courage because it can often be misunderstood and lead to rejection and hostility.

As a church, we are called to bind and loosen; to bind the forces of evil which enslave and to loosen the bonds of oppression which prevent people from living the fullness of life in God's kingdom.

Our motivation, like Jesus', must always be love and compassion. If we lose sight of that, our efforts will eventually be mean spirited, intolerant, and judgmental. Remember the words of St. Paul. 'Love does no evil to your neighbor; hence love is the fulfillment of the law.' (Rom. 13:10)

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### INFANT BAPTISM:

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

### CONFIRMATION

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

### MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
