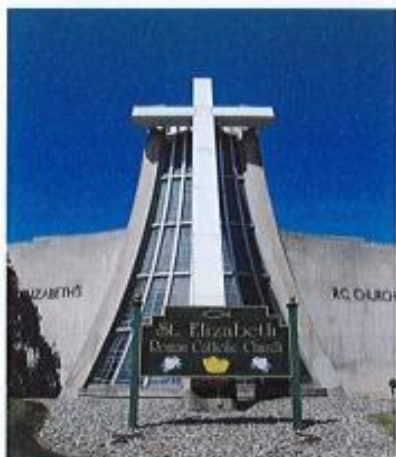

### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation** (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Today's gospel is not a commentary on social justice. In this parable, Jesus is teaching us about the kingdom of God. What we hear at the end of the gospel is that the first shall be last and vice versa is a reminder of Jesus' life and ministry. God does not come to us with a contract in hand, but He offers us a covenant.

What people get from serving God and living as disciples is not what we would recognize as a paycheck or a wage. Jesus goes to great lengths to show us that the kingdom of heaven is not a business deal. It is not a contract. It is a covenant. Contracts are things people negotiate, make compromises with and reach terms. A covenant is something God gives with no negotiation. God gives it out of divine pleasure and love. A covenant is not a reward for our efforts, but the natural outflow of God's grace inviting us to respond.

We understand that in our minds theologically, but we live with a bottom-line mentality. The questions are always; What do we get? and What's in it for us? The conclusions drawn inevitably are that it's just not fair. That's the frustration viewed by the workers in the

vineyard and then Jesus shares with us the truths of the kingdom of heaven. Seniority doesn't count. The only thing that counts is God's covenant with us. 'Are you envious because I am generous?' Then the Lord says the last will be first and the first last.

This front to back and last to first parable rearranges the way we think about what is right, and about what justice looks like. It might be helpful to look at this from another perspective. Imagine that you are the parents of three children: age 3, 6 and 9 years old. Do you love the 9-year-old three times as much as the 3-year-old because the child has been around three times longer? Do you love the 6-year-old twice as much as the 3-year-old? Do you love the 3-year-old less because they are really no help right now and won't be for a while? Of course not, that's ridiculous! You are a family.

That is the point Jesus is making. Families are not built upon contracts. At their best, families, marriage, faith, and true love are about covenant. This is Jesus' story and it's an important one to hear and take to heart.

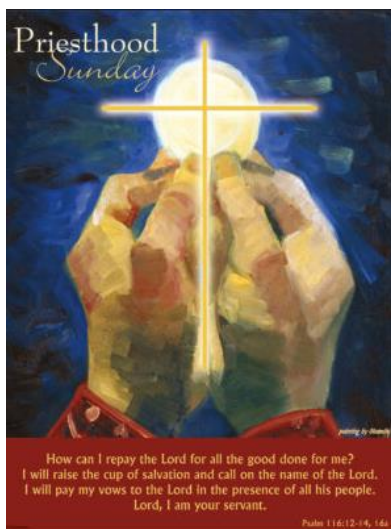
## RECONCILIATION / CONFESSION

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### INFANT BAPTISM:

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

### CONFIRMATION

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

### MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

### RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS: (R.C.I.A.)
