

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) - Saturday 3:30 - 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism - First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage - Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick - Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



'Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.' This is one of the most well-known verses in Scripture. Although it might appear that Jesus is trying to instruct the Pharisees and their followers on lawfulness, it seems that this is one more instance of Jesus taking a question ('Is it lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not?') and answering it in a way to reveal a deeper truth. He takes a question about what is owed to Caesar and responds with an answer about what is owed to God.

Jesus was not angry at the Pharisees for trying to entrap Him (although He does call them hypocrites). He gives them this answer because they were so fixated on every little aspect of the law, fixated on the 'practice of religion' rather than on faithful living.

Jesus is asking us if we too, are overly focused on small moral decisions while failing to consider our over-arching call to be loving, generous, merciful, compassionate, and forgiving. Do we give God what is God's (that is our 'whole self'), or do we give something less? Is God, in our sight at all times, in our minds every moment, in our hearts in good times and bad, or do the things of the world have most of our attention?

Our lives may depend on how we answer that question. Remember, 'give to God, what belongs to God.'



CONFIRMATION

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.




A Gracious "Basket Social" Thank You


