

#### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office, Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

#### Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) - Saturday 3:30 - 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism - First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage - Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



#### What is 40 Hours?

Forty Hours is a special devotion of the Blessed Sacrament over a period of three days, during which prayers continue uninterrupted for an approximate total of Forty Hours. The devotions begin with a Mass and end with a Eucharistic procession and benediction. Forty hours are similar to a parish mission or retreat but allow more time for personal prayer and devotion and fewer talks. It is a time to be alone for personal prayer but also for our parish family to come together as a community for liturgical prayer.

The number forty and the period of three days is a remembrance of the Forty hours from Jesus' burial until his resurrection, but also a remembrance of the Forty day fast of Jesus in the desert.

Since we do not have continuous exposition over the three days, the exposition will take place after the 10 am Mass on Sunday and the 9 am Mass on Monday and Tuesday. Adoration will take place in the Church on Sunday and in the Chapel on Monday and Tuesday until 5 pm when the adoration will be transferred to the Church.

Each evening at 7 pm, we will join as a community in prayer to pray 'Vespers' which is also known as Evening Prayer. We are honored to have Msgr. Bill Glosser who will be our homilist for the three evenings and the theme of his talks will be 'Stay Awake'. After Vespers on Sunday and Monday there will be Benediction (Blessing) of the Blessed Sacrament. At the conclusion of Vespers on Tuesday, there will be a Eucharistic Procession in the Church followed by Benediction.

The Forty Hour devotions are deeply rooted in our belief that it is Jesus who is truly present, Body and Blood, Soul, and Divinity, under the form of Bread and Wine in the Eucharist. Our participation in the Forty Hour devotions can give us the spiritual renewal we need to reawaken our faith and deepen our appreciation of the Eucharist in our life.

Take advantage of this special time to draw closer to our Lord and rest in His peace.



Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

#### **CONFIRMATION**

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

#### **MARRIAGE:**

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

#### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.




