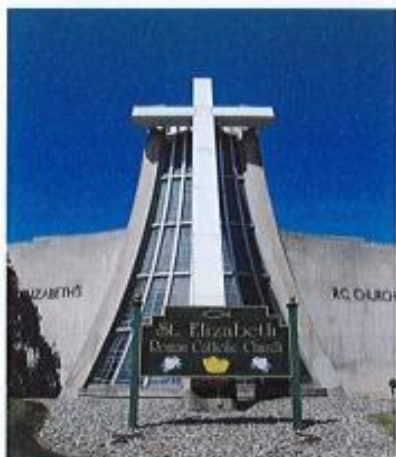

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



As difficult as it is to hear the words of God to Abraham in the first Reading, *'Take your son Isaac...whom you love...and offer him up as a holocaust'*, we need to view this in context with the parallels of Jesus' life. Christ is a descendant of Abraham and just as Jesus carried his cross, Isaac carried the wood for the sacrifice. Abraham was willing to sacrifice his beloved son for God; God *did* sacrifice His son for us.

God's sacrifice of His son for us is at the heart of Saint Paul's message to the Romans today. *'If God is for us, who can be against us?'* God loves us, and this love was made known when God *'did not spare His own Son but handed Him over for us all'*. Because of this we have reason to hope, since Jesus intercedes for us.

This hope is brought to light in today's Gospel account of the Transfiguration of Jesus. Accompanied by three of His disciples, Jesus goes up to a mountain. While they were there, Jesus was transfigured before them. Then Moses and Elijah appeared, and they were conversing with Jesus. Overshadowed by a cloud, the disciples heard a voice declaring, *'This is my beloved Son, listen to Him'*. And suddenly they are once again alone with Jesus.

The Transfiguration of Jesus demonstrates His divine nature and manifested the glory He has always possessed and would return to upon leaving His earthly human body. It is also a prefiguring of the glory we shall one day obtain in our resurrected bodies. If we live and die with Christ - if we do in fact listen to Him, He will intercede for us - then we shall take our place among our ancestors, as Christ showed on that mountain.

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

INFANT BAPTISM:

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for two years before reception.

CONFIRMATION

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before reception.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

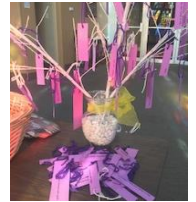
