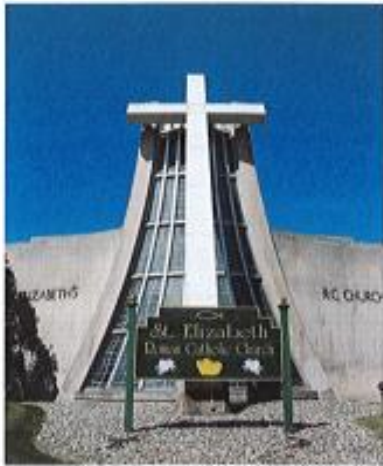

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, or the Body of Christ. Twenty-two years ago on this feast, I along with my four classmates, celebrated our first Mass after our ordination. For the first time since then, the Diocese of Allentown is blessed to ordain five men to the priesthood who will be celebrating their first Mass after ordination today. We thank God for this blessing.

When we reflect on Corpus Christi, or the Body of Christ, we think of Holy Communion. Which would be correct. After the second Vatican Council, the church began referring to the sacrament increasingly as 'Eucharist', a word which means thanksgiving. That term is often used to describe both the sacred liturgy as a whole, and in a particular way, the Body and Blood of Jesus, the Blessed Sacrament. Why the change? Apparently, the church in her wisdom decided that Eucharist was a more accurate and traditional way of articulating what the faithful were expected to be doing every Sunday, in churches and other holy places around the world. We gather as a people of faith to simply give thanks.

This makes sense. After all, everything is a gift from God. Nothing is a greater gift than the gift of God's very self to us, in His teaching, His shepherding, in His sacrifice

on Calvary, and on this altar. We can never repay God for His generosity, nor do we deserve it in the first place. We are left with being able to give thanks, to be a Eucharistic people, with grateful and humble hearts.

There are many ways to show our thanks to God who has done so much for us. When it comes to giving thanks to God for the gift of His Body and Blood, there seems to be only one way that is most appropriate. Ironically, it is 'communion'. The sincerest way to show our thanks for what we experience every Sunday at the altar is to strive for the communion it represents.

We are one family. We have one mission. We have one destiny. We have one Lord. Our relationships should reflect that reality. We come to this altar as a community not so that we can connect with God as individuals, but so that we can become a family of faith. We take the Body of Christ so that we may BE the Body of Christ. We receive communion so that we can BE in communion. If we don't honestly long for it and work toward it, can we really say we are thankful? Food for thought, and food for our souls. Thank you, God, for both.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: *(Infant to Age 6)*

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

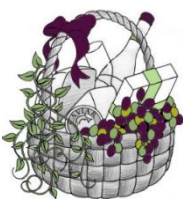
SENIOR ALTAR SERVERS / SACRISTAN

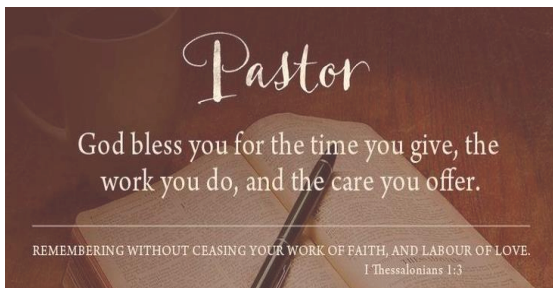
