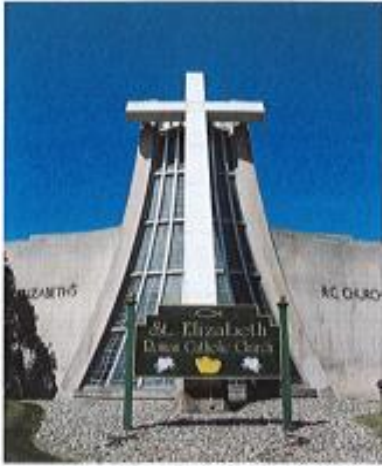

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles is perfect for us today. The choosing of Matthias to replace Judas takes place after the Ascension of Jesus and before the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.

While the methodology for choosing Matthias may seem odd to us, it was customary practice for our Jewish ancestors in faith to 'cast lots' to make important decisions. What should not be missed in our puzzlement of the casting of lots is that the Apostles prayed together before making this major decision - a choice that would have immediate impact on this very new church.

This was certainly true throughout the lives of the spiritual leaders of Israel so it would seem a natural approach for these new leaders of a fledgling church. It makes sense that we should bring decisions, especially the

important ones, before the Lord in prayer and not leave them to chance.

When we bring decisions before the Lord and heed His voice in our hearts on a regular basis, then we understand what John is talking about in the second reading today when he states, 'We have come to know and to believe in the love God has for us'.

Jesus' prayer is for us to be one with Him and the Father. Admitting that we are all works in progress, we must nonetheless commit ourselves to being one with the Father, as is Jesus. The more we allow ourselves to be one with Jesus in mind and in heart, the easier our decisions - important decisions, even life changing decisions, will become.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

INFANT BAPTISM:

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
