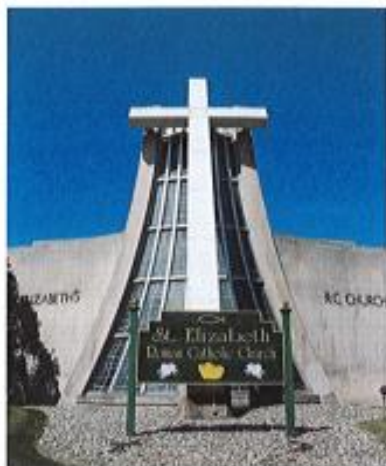

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



The account of the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples at Pentecost was just one more way that we know that this church, is founded by Christ to be His Presence in the world. The source and summit of our unity with Jesus is brought about when we celebrate and when we receive Jesus, the Body of Christ in Holy Communion. Historically speaking, what is the difference between the world before Christ and the world after Christ? The world now has the church and that makes all the difference. You and I together are the church, the enduring presence of Christ in the world. The world should be different because there are Christians in it.

We pray that the Holy Spirit may come and renew the face of the earth. This happens through the church, that is, through you and me. The church is the way in which God renews the face of the earth.

God, through the Holy Spirit, moves us - nudging us ever so slightly or shaking us to our core when we need it most. By all accounts, looking at our world today, all of us could use a bit of shaking right now. We need to be shaken from the perspectives of our comfort that cause our inability to see the poverty that surrounds us, or racism that rests not only in hearts but that is built into every structure

of our society, or the fear of otherness that perverts the beauty of our beloved communities.

The Holy Spirit shakes, causing us to hear and understand each other, especially perspectives we actively or passively choose not to listen to or comprehend. The Holy Spirit that Jesus gives also greets us in the comfort of our locked rooms, where we hide from the realities of our wounded lives and broken world. He offers us peace. In that peace we are given the courage to unlock doors and meet the world outside. We receive the Holy Spirit, which allows us to forgive ourselves and to show others how to do the same, in the name of a liberating God.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
