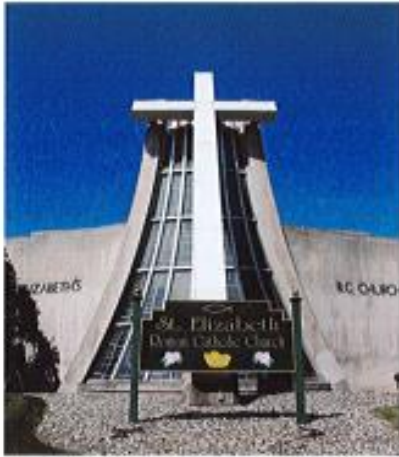

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

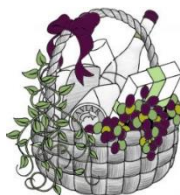

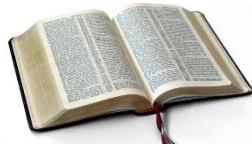

**UPCOMING PROJECTS AT ST. ELIZABETH**

• **The New Electronic Sign**

We will be replacing the current green sign and portable sign with a permanent LED electronic sign. This sign will announce upcoming events, display the weather, date and time regularly. The surrounding grounds will be landscaped, and new lighting will be installed. The projected time frame is August.

• **The New Tabernacle**

A few years ago, the Bishop announced the preference for the Tabernacle at the center of the altar rather than off to the side as many churches have it. Fr. Stan undertook the effort of moving our tabernacle to under the resurrection cross. Through the generosity of Irene Snyder, a new Tabernacle has been purchased and will be placed as soon as possible.

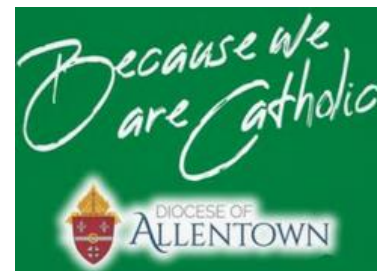
• **School Asbestos Abatement**

Many years ago, the ceilings of the school were encapsulated to ensure any asbestos would be contained. The diocese instructed us this last year that they want all asbestos removed from diocesan buildings. Therefore, this summer the ceilings of the school will be removed by asbestos specialists and then a remodeling company will install new LED lights and install new ceilings.

### Angelorum, the Women's Choir of the Diocese of Allentown

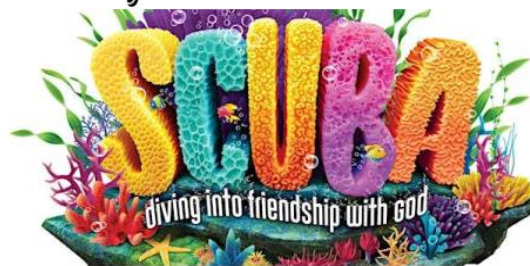
