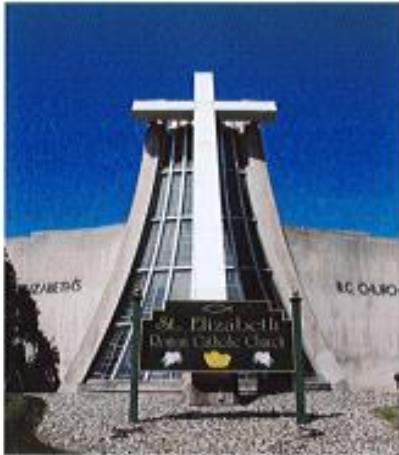

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

At every Mass we pray the "Our Father". There is a bit of mystery in the phrase "Give us this day our daily bread." We ask for the bread that we need for today. The word "daily" has a deeper meaning in the Greek word 'epiousion' and came to be understood through the writings of St. Jerome and St. Thomas More to be supersubstantial bread.

In the first reading from Second Kings, Elisha directed that the offering of twenty barley loaves and some fresh grain be distributed among some one hundred people. The servants argued how inadequate the portion would be among so many. The Lord had assured us that there would be some left over and there was.

In the Gospel, a much larger crowd was assembled. Jesus asked Philip, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?" Philip answered that even with two hundred days wages it would not be enough bread for them all.

Andrew, who was an amazing fisherman, was able to locate two fish and five barley loaves. Jesus distributed the food among the five the crowd of five thousand. There were twelve wicker baskets filled with leftovers.

These examples illustrate the power of God to fulfill and exceed all our material, emotional and spiritual needs. We should have faith that our concerns and expectations will be met by Him.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.
