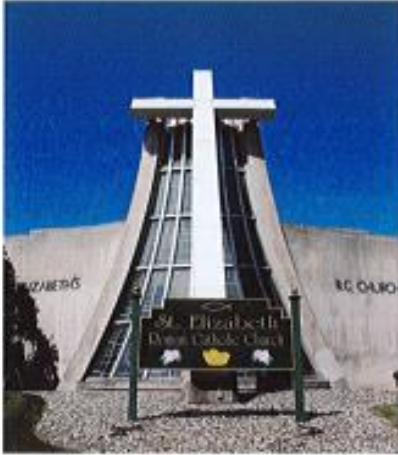

Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

Sacraments

Reconciliation (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

Baptism – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

Marriage – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

Anointing of the Sick – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

WRITINGS FROM DEACON

In our first reading this week, Moses instructed the people of Israel to observe the teachings that they may live. In doing this they gave evidence of their wisdom and intelligence to the nations. Over time, the rules became more complex. Some directives became exaggerated and perhaps burdensome.

A few years ago, we had CDC guidelines. Washing our hands thoroughly, double masking, maintaining six-foot distances and one-way routing through grocery stores to do our best to keep ourselves and others safe. Many of our procedures were excessive and arbitrary but, because of the unknown, were well intentioned. Certainly, cleansing and hygiene are not a bad thing.

In the gospel, the Pharisees determine that the disciples had not been following their equivalent of the six-foot, one-way rule. The Pharisees expressed their observation to Jesus expecting Him to correct and properly instruct His followers to embrace the whole law, to carefully fulfill the statutes and decrees of the law as taught by Moses.

Jesus counters with the observation, that the greatest problem is that their hearts are much greater than six feet separated from God. Our words and works can be steps of service to God and to others. What truly matters is what comes from within. We are blessed in what good comes from our hearts and are judged by what evil proceeds from our hearts.

SACRAMENTS

New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.

BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2nd grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8th grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

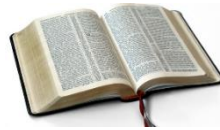
