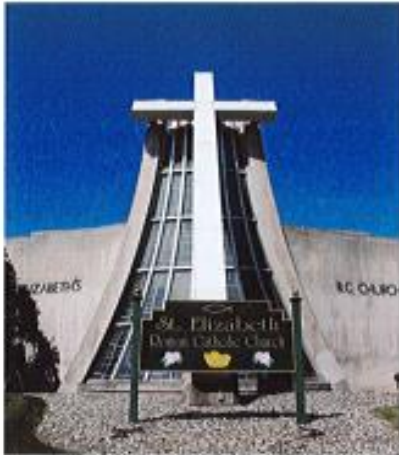

### Parish Registration

Roman Catholics living in the parish boundaries should be registered with St. Elizabeth of Hungary. Registration and regular participation at Mass are required for the administration of the Sacraments, Certificate of Eligibility, and attendance in C.Y.O. and P.R.E.P. Please register at the parish office. Registration packets are also located in the church foyer and on the church website.

### Sacraments

**Reconciliation** (Confession) – Saturday 3:30 – 4:15 PM and by appointment.

**Baptism** – First Sunday of the month. Please contact the parish office early in the pregnancy to begin arrangements. Family must be registered with the parish. Preparation class for parents is held monthly.

**Marriage** – Engaged couples should contact the parish office at least six months in advance of their proposed wedding in order to set a date with the priest. Either the groom or bride should be a registered parishioner and practicing at St. Elizabeth of Hungary.

**RCIA** – Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. Would you like to learn more about the Catholic faith or become Catholic? Please contact the parish office for information and scheduling.

**Anointing of the Sick** – Hospitals are visited on a regular basis. Please call the parish office to report emergencies.

**Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors** – You must be registered with the parish, be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. All requests for 'Certificate of Eligibility' are to be made well in advance to the parish office.

### WRITINGS FROM DEACON

“Who do people say that I am?” Jesus asked the disciples during a road trip to Caesarea Philippi. Various perspectives were shared ... ‘John the Baptist...Elijah...a prophet’. Jesus said, “But who do you say that I am?” Peter replied, “You are the Christ.”

The *consequence* of who Jesus is has remained immutable. Jesus is Lord and savior, redeemer, only begotten son of the Father, truly God and truly human, coeternal with the Holy Spirit and the Father in the Trinity, the full revelation to man of the divine.

What does change is not the essence of God but our *understanding* of Him. Peter became inspired to perceive Jesus as the Christ ... the long-awaited Messiah. The common understanding of the time was that the Messiah would be a great political and military conqueror. The inspired understanding of Peter was outside of the conventional.

What also changes is our *response*. We understand in marriage, love is a decision. We daily choose to grow in our relationship with our spouse. We should daily choose to grow in our relationship with the church ... as the bride of Christ. We are invited to grow daily in our understanding and commitment to Christ ... to embrace the consequence of all that He is and all that we are called to.

## SACRAMENTS

*New to the parish? – Register as a new member to receive Sacraments.*

### BAPTISM: (Infant to Age 6)

Baptisms are currently being celebrated on the first Sunday of the month. Registered parish members may contact the parish office as soon as they learn that a child is on the way but should contact the parish office at least two months prior to the Baptism to register for the Baptism Class.

### FIRST PENANCE / EUCHARIST:

Normally received in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### CONFIRMATION:

Normally received in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Parish member's enrollment in St. Elizabeth Regional School or Parish Religious Education Program (P.R.E.P) is required for at least two years before sacrament is received.

### MARRIAGE:

At least six months before your anticipated wedding. Contact the pastor for a meeting to go over information regarding scheduling and the preparation process.

### PASTORAL CARE OF THE SICK:

Contact our parish office for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick prior to surgery or during serious illness. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound monthly.

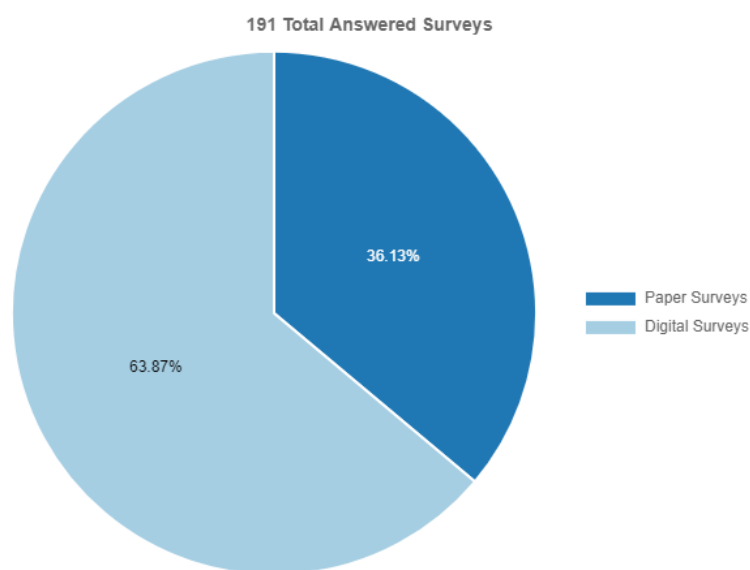
